## **UNESCO**

Lead: UNESCO HQ and Asia-Pacific

- Micro-credentials, a study aiming to reach a consensus on a proposed definition (2021)
- Global Convention on the Recognition of Qualifications concerning Higher Education (Global Convention) was adopted by UNESCO Member States in November 2019, becoming the first United Nations treaty in higher education with a global scope
- Global Inventory of NQFs and RQFs



### **Global Convention on Higher Education**

Today, out of 235 million students worldwide, 6 million are studying abroad, up from 2 million in 2000. More than half of the 6 million are studying outside their region. In November 2019, the Global Convention on the Recognition of Qualifications concerning Higher Education was adopted by the 40th session of the UNESCO General Conference, becoming the first United Nations treaty on higher education with a global scope.

The Global Convention establishes universal principles for fair, transparent and non-discriminatory
