2. Get applicants from "Nominated" status to "Accepted", "Conditionally accepted", or "Rejected" status.




Method:








Goals:

1. Generating (in DreamApply system or outside) formal Acceptance Letter document and sending it to the applicant.



[TimeSpentPerInstitution](#)

Shows the average time spent from first submission until the first feedback/offer and the average time spent per country in days.
