The University of Antwerp offers a wide variety of advanced master and ostgraduate programmes taught in Dutch.

About ECTS credits

The University of Antwerp applies ECTS (= European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System) in all its degree programmes. All study programmes re measured in terms of ECTS credits.

A full-time one-year study programme amounts to 60 credits (30 credits per nester), which comprises a student workload of about 1,500 to 1,800 hours. ne credit stands for 25 to 30 hours of work including contact hours, preparatory ork, study and assessment.
